


Dear Marvin Choristers, and Friends of our Choir ('Groupies!')


May 30: BARCELONA - GOTHIC CATHEDRAL



May 31: BARCELONA - La SAGRADA FAMILIA

After breakfast, we transfer to La Sagrada Familia also known as the Basilica of the Holy Family, where our choir will offer music in the chapel where Gaudi is buried. We enjoy a self-guided tour of Gaudi's masterpiece, La Sagrada Familia. Our coach will transport us back to our hotel, but you may decide to enjoy the area around La Sagrada, if you prefer to return to the hotel on your own. We enjoy dinner as a group at our hotel restaurant in the evening. [B, D]

June 1: TOLEDO

June 4: SEVILLE

This morning, we will tour the immense cathedral of Seville with the historic Giralda Tower. In the afternoon, our choir will offer music in concert [TBA.] The rest of the day is at your leisure. [B]

June 5: SEVILLE

This morning, we will tour the Plaza de Toros, the most significant arena for the Spanish tradition of bull fighting. The rest of the day is at your leisure. [B]

June 6: LISBON

We load our coach and transfer to Lisbon, the coastal capitol of Portugal. We check into our hotel, which is located in the historic city center of Lisbon. Enjoy the afternoon and evening at leisure in this beautiful city. [B]

June 7: LISBON

Lisbon is quite hilly, so we enjoy a guided tour by bus through a few neighborhoods and attractions that showcase churches, cuisines, and castles. The trams and tuk-tuks are a friendly way of exploring the city on your own this afternoon. [B]

June 8: LISBON

We enjoy a full free day in Lisbon. We gather at the hotel restaurant to enjoy a group dinner this evening. Pack your bags after dinner as we head to Porto, in the morning. [B,D]

June 9: PORTO

We travel by coach to Porto. En-route, we stop for a guided tour of the Sanctuary of our Lady of Fatima. We make comfort stops along the way, before we check-in to our hotel in Porto, which is well situated in a historic neighborhood. [B]

June 10: PORTO

After breakfast, we head to the fortified cathedral of Porto, which overlooks the city and the bay. The chancel choir will offer music in concert. The afternoon is free-time, and we conclude our travels with a celebration dinner at our hotel restaurant. [B,D]

June 11: RETURN FLIGHT

Our fabulous tour must unfortunately come to an end. Our coach will transport us to the Porto Airport where we will board our flight home to Dallas DFW.
